Evidence of need

- The persistent skills gap existing in multiple industries across the state
- Statutory requirements for career and academic planning that are not currently supported or funded by state resources
- Counselor to student ratios of 1:400 and 1:900 in secondary and post-secondary education settings
- A high number of students who begin post-secondary education and choose not to return for the second year, resulting in credit accumulation and debt burden without attainment of marketable credentials


